## **Hampers**

If your child is not in school and you requested a hamper please come to collect these after 12pm on Monday 11th and every Monday after that. Just to confirm there is currently no voucher scheme. If this changes, we will let you know.

## **Attendance**

We expect all children who have a place to attend school every day unless they are ill. From Monday please follow all the usual procedures and let us know why your child will be absent.

Children, unless in breakfast club or after school club must be brought to school between 8.30-9am and picked up 3-3.10pm.

You **must** follow the rules about isolating to keep the children, staff and wider community safe. **Do not** send your children to school if anyone living in your house or anyone they have had close contact with has symptoms and has had a test. They can only return after a negative test result or after 10 days if the test is positive.

## <u>Uniform</u>

Whilst we are still encouraging children to wear uniform, please be aware that due to our increased Covid controls we are opening windows in all rooms. Despite having the heating on throughout the day, some rooms are colder than others. Your child can bring extra layers, which are not uniform if needed.
