Although you may have some anxiety about this I am sure it is also a relief that children are returning to face to face learning and that you will no longer have to be home teachers. All children must arrive between 8.30-9.00am. This is to prevent everyone arriving at once to help with social distancing in the school grounds. We also have staggered end times.

Nursery – Please collect children who attend morning nursery only at 11.30am and bring afternoon nursery children at 12.30pm.

Children will not be brought to after school club or to the office until 3.30pm so please go to the pick-up points above and not to the main office.



Parking

As we all return to school we know the problem with cars outside at busy times may start again. We want to avoid this to make sure everyone is safe. Please be mindful of the dangers of parking on curbs and on the yellow lines. We do not want any accidents. It is also very difficult for our local residents at busy times and you must not block their driveways. The local police have confirmed that routine spot checks will be made and this will result in a fine for anyone parking illegally.

Free School Meal hampers

Leeds Catering are providing all children eligible for benefits free school meals with a hamper for the two weeks of the Easter holiday. This is part of the government's winter food scheme. These will be delivered to school and distributed to you at the end of the school day. The day has yet to be confirmed. Please let school know if you do not want to receive this by phone or email. There is no voucher alternative available.



On the 24th of March, the 0-19 Public Health Integrated Nursing Service will be in school to carry out the National Child Measurement Programme and Vision screening for children in reception. This is part of a national scheme to ensure children have the support they need. More details will follow.



After School Club - You must pay for all the days you have booked for the week on a Monday. This includes days you have booked but do not use. If not your place will be offered to someone else.

Breakfast Club- Ideally should be paid for on a Monday or the first day of the week, your child attends. If your child does not attend you will be charged if you booked a place, again if you do not pay each week your place will be offered to someone on the waiting list.

Please cancel places you no longer need, we have a very long waiting list and we would like to support as many parents as possible. We currently have no places in breakfast or after school club.

Relationships, Sex and Health Education

In line with government guidance the school is currently reviewing the policy on Relationships and Sex Education. The new RSE curriculum is due to be delivered in school from Summer 2021. As part of the development of the new curriculum we would like to consult with parents and carers. We would like to invite you to view the information on the school website, read the policy, listen to the power point presentation and complete the consultation questionnaire. The consultation period will end on Friday the 19th March.

The governors have agreed this adapted Leeds Model Policy and Curriculum and a group of governor RSE leads in school have worked with key staff in school to review it.

The information can be found on the school website under 'Parents' and 'Relationships and Sex Education' we look forward to receiving your responses.

Isolating

You must follow the rules about isolating to keep the children, staff and wider community safe.

<u>Do not</u> send your children to school if they or anyone living in your house has symptoms. Please arrange a test and you must all stay at home. They can only return after a negative test result or after 10 days if the test is positive.
