Reception – This week we have been spending lots of time reading, retelling and writing our own stories. Story time has quickly become our favourite time of the day and the children are getting really good at telling their own stories using story language. We have been completing lots of different activities linked to our favourite books such as creating tinfoil knights from 'zog' and printing the scales on the 'rainbow fish'. We had a lovely afternoon on Friday reading bedtime stories in our pyjamas. Look out for the photos on learning journals and the website.

Year 2-Year 2 have retold the story of Toby and the Fire of London and are now learning about diaries and writing in the past tense. In Maths we are finishing off our topic of fractions, applying it in different ways and looking at equivalent fractions. In Art we have created mosaics and collages of London burning which can be seen on the website. In Science and PSHE we have just finished our topics about healthy lifestyles and in computing we have learnt how to take, edit and upload photographs.

Year 3 & 4 – This week, Year 3 have been looking at adding powerful verbs into sentences to up level them. In Maths, they have continued looking at money and calculating how much change they would receive if they bought items in a shop. Year 4 have been reading poems to develop fluency and intonation when reading. In Maths, we have begun our work on fractions. In Geography, we have returned to our big question; why are rainforests so wet and deserts so dry? We have also finished our dreamcatchers. Have a happy and safe half term!

Year 5 & 6 – Bikeability - Children in Year 5 have been given their Bikeability letters and it is very important permission slips are brought back into school. The following weeks will involve the following classes:

Well done to all children in Year 5 for their amazing creations: making animals through the recycling of materials. The work has been of a very high standard.
