- ✓ Parking the yellow lines have been repainted outside the main entrance. This is to remind people not to park illegally and put children at risk. If you park on the curb it also makes it difficult for people walking and those who have a pushchair or use a wheelchair. It is difficult and busy at the start and end of the day but please consider others and walk your children to school if possible, it is healthier too!
- ✓ Years 4 and 5 Rock Steady is still available for those who are interested, please look at the letter that was sent out or ask for another.
- ✓ Please make sure your child's name is in their jumpers, cardigans and coats. As the weather improves the children tend to take them off whilst playing and forget to pick them back up. It is very difficult to get lost items back to children when they have no names in. Thank you.

**Punctuality** - Unfortunately we have an increasing number of children arriving late to school. This is causing additional work for the office and affecting what they should be doing at that time. <u>More</u> <u>importantly children are missing their education and going into lessons late can be upsetting</u>.
