<u>Photograph Day</u> - All children will be having their photo taken on Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> September. Children will be taken with their siblings that are in school. If you would like a family photo with yourselves or younger children who do not attend our school, please come to the office between 8.30 and 8.50am.

**Data Collection** - On Tuesday your children will come home with the annual data collection sheet. Please check the details, make any changes and return to school. It is vital that they are all returned.

<u>**Clothing-**</u> As the weather gets colder, children are coming to school in jumpers, cardigans and coats and these sometimes get lost and left. It is really important that your child's name is in their clothes so they can be quickly returned to them if lost. If they do not have names in, we will try to do this in school but your help would be appreciated.

<u>Headlice</u> - Head Lice are a common problem in school aged children. They can't be prevented, but regular checking ensures early detection and treatment if necessary. Parents and carers should check their children's head once a week during hair washing. You need your usual shampoo, conditioner, and a detection comb – ask your local pharmacist to recommend a suitable one. Remember that you are looking for living moving lice, which is the only evidence that your child is infected. If you find a living louse, sellotape it to a piece of light coloured paper and take it to your local pharmacy (Leeds only) who will advise you and can provide free Hedrin lotion under the Pharmacy First Minor Ailments Scheme. Combs are available from the office.

<u>High School Applications</u> - High school applications for children in Year 6 are now open (closing date is 31<sup>st</sup> October 2022). If you need any help with applying online for a high school – please contact school to speak to Mr Needham.

<u>Flu Letters</u>- Flu forms must be returned no later than Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> September in the morning when you drop your child at school. No late forms will be accepted.
