#### Weekly Round Up

**Nursery** - In Nursery this week, we have been learning about Christmas. We read 'Christmas story' and 'Dear Santa'. We have opened up Santa's workshop in which children have been wrapping toys and weighing the presents. **Reception** – This week in Reception, we have been reading the Christmas Pine we have talked about Christmas trees and the traditions around Christmas. We have enjoyed learning about how the Christmas tree that stands in Trafalgar square travels from Norway each year as a gift. We have talked about other Christmas traditions such as making gingerbread men and singing carols we are looking forward to performing our concert next week and have been working really hard with all the songs. **Year 1 & 2** - It has been a very exciting week in Year 1 as the children have received a special package in the post. Stickman has come to stay in classes 3 and 4!!! The children have enjoyed listening to the story and looked at the different characters. They have practised writing the character names using capital letters because they are proper nouns. The children have written letters to Stick Lady to say they are looking after Stickman and taking care of him. In Year 2, the children have loved the start of their author study on Anthony Browne. They have read Voices in the Park and have looked at the different characters and have written words and phrases to describe them.

**Year 3 & 4** – This week has been our assessment week, which helps teachers know what to plan for after Christmas. We have also been busy practising our Christmas play and look forward to sharing this with parents. Class 8 also had an amazing trip to the theatre to see Oliver Twist!
