Something Mrs Wainwright has enjoyed this week has been seeing the children return to school after the holiday with such a positive attitude.

Worship – Our new theme is <u>Perseverance</u> and this week we have started to look at what that means and how we can use our faith and beliefs to help us keep going when things become difficult.

CAR PARKING – Unfortunately, several of our parents have received parking fines this week. These have been issued by wardens for parking on the yellow lines or mounting the curb to park where the yellow lines are. We again ask you to park legally and safely. We also ask that if you park at the other side of school you do not block residents' drives. We are aware of how difficult parking is around school as there is such little space but we have no influence over this and can only ask you to consider how and where you park if coming to school to drop off and collect your children by car.



Primary School Application - If your child is due to start Reception in September 2024, the deadline to apply is **Monday 15th January 2024.**

Attendance – Last term (September – December) attendance was a great improvement on the previous year but we want to be better. Being in school on time is the only way our children are going to make the best progress and reach their potential and fully join in school life.

Nursery - 89.2%

Reception to Year 6 – 95.5%

We expect all children to be in school every day unless too ill to attend, this does not include a common cold. If you have any issues with getting your children to school on time, please ask and we may be able to offer you support with this.
