- School Gateway App Reminder we need everyone to download the school gateway app, as this Schoolgateway will be how messages are sent out to parents/carers. Please make sure you have your notifications turned on so you do not miss any messages.





Milk - We will be providing children in Years 1-6 with the opportunity to have milk in school for the spring term. Nursery and Reception children already receive it free of charge. For children entitled to benefit related free school meals this will be free but you must still complete a form for the spring term requesting this for your child, for all others it must be ordered and paid for in advance for the

term. The cost for the spring term will be £18.00. Forms can be collected from the office from Monday 9th December. All forms must be completed and returned to the office by Monday 16th December. Payments can be made by ParentPay or card at the office, if you would like to pay by ParentPay, please call or message the office to let us know then we can add it to your account. We cannot accept late payments, as we need to order the milk in advance. Once this has been paid, we cannot provide refunds.

Year 3 & 4 - This week, Years 3 and 4 have started looking at similes and metaphors, whilst looking at Christmas poems. In Science, we have finished our topic on rocks, fossils and soil. Class 8 also enjoyed their trip to the theatre and classes 8 and 11 enjoyed their trip to the coal-mining museum.
