Results - From the results of the questionnaire it can be seen that questions 8 and 9 were the questions with the highest percentage of parents that strongly disagreed or disagreed with 85% or less of parents that agreed or strongly agreed with these questions. The school will complete the following actions.

Actions

1. **Ensure that parents are well informed about activities, events and courses through the school website, flyers, posters, letters, emails, texts and face to face discussion.**
2. **Develop a lego club for SEND pupils and ensure that parents of SEND pupils are well informed of all other clubs and community events taking place. Monitor the percentage of SEND pupils taking part in clubs and schemes.**
3. **Appoint a School Council SEND Member to contribute to decision making which includes the planning of a range of activities and events.**
