WHAT HAS BEEN GOING ON?

In **Key Stage 1**, children have used the musical composition 'The Carnival of the Animals', by French composer Camille Saint-Saëns, as a stimulus for mark making. They thought about what feelings were elicited as they listened and made marks to represent those feelings.







In **Year 3 and 4**, children have been learning about the artist Giorgio Morandi.

have made They compositions of still life and using viewfinders to focus on contour lines.





In Year 5 and 6, children began their topic by experimenting with different materials. They produced sketches of fruit using watercolour paints, oil pastels

coloured pencils.





Children then went on to produce self-portraits, which they will be creating abstract backgrounds for. This is based on the work of Frida Kahlo and surrealism.
