WHAT HAVE WE BEEN LEARNING IN EARLY YEARS?




WHAT HAVE WE BEEN LEARNING IN KS1?

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
WHAT HAVE WE BEEN LEARNING IN LOWER KS2?

In Years 3, 3/4 and 4, we have been reading Varjak Paw and The Boy at the Back of the Class. Varjak Paw is the story of a cat who learns about the way of Jalal, a secret martial art for cats. We discussed themes of tenacity, bravery, self-belief and adventure. The Boy at the Back of the Class is the story of a Syrian refugee arriving in the UK highlighting the importance of kindness and friendship. We have written stories from other cultures, explanatory texts, third person adventure stories and poetry.



WHAT HAVE WE BEEN LEARNING IN UPPER KS2?

In Year 5, 5/6 and 6, we have been 'Rooftoppers' and will be moving on to 'Pig Heart Boy'. We have written autobiographies based on Windrush, extended 3rd person narratives and newspaper reports about the 2011 Japanese tsunami.
