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

Look at this map to see all of the floods we had in August and September this year, wow!

Between July 2023 and June 2024, the Environment Agency reported 266 category 1-3 water pollution incidents!



In response to the increased water pollution generated by raw sewage, the government intends to pass a Water Bill that will impose harsher penalties to water companies and their executives who are found to be illegally polluting waterways.
