In **Early Years**, Nursery have been learning all about number 1 and Reception have subitising.

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WHAT HAS BEEN GOING ON?



In Key Stage 1, children have been making the most of the outdoors by using conkers when working on finding 1 more/ 1 less as well as drawing giant 🖪 chalk number lines on the playground to estimate where numbers go. They have used giant Numicon to find number bonds to 10 with the Year 2s using it to solve 'missing part' questions.

In Mastering Number Y1 have recently been consolidating their understanding 🗖 of doubles whilst Y2 have been reasoning about the composition of odd numbers. Scan the QR codes to access L Numberblocks episodes linked to their learning.

In Year 3 and 4, children have been using Base 10 to develop their understanding of Place Value. The manipulatives support children to articulate their understanding, developing their 'maths talk' and it has been particularly helpful when working on flexible partitioning.



In Mastering Number the Year 4s have been developing their understanding of unitising to support them with multiplication.



In Year 5 and 6, the children have been using manipulatives to visualise mathematical concepts when approaching complex problems to support them in persevering in solving them.
