In **Early Years**, children have studied Alma Thomas, specifically looking at 'Springtime in Washington' and creating their own work inspired by this.







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
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


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WHAT HAS BEEN GOING ON?

In **Key Stage 1**, children have explored the work of Wassily Kandinsky. They focused on creating artwork with geometric shapes and painting them using primary colours. Children have now moved onto looking at concentric shapes!





In **Year 3 and 4**, children have enjoyed exploring the use of wet-on-wet techniques in Art. Inspired by the work of Georgia O'Keefe, they have used this technique to create their own flower paintings. Children used viewfinders to study the patterns and lines in flowers and created their own tertiary colours to develop some wonderful designs!







In **Year 5 and 6**, children have explored the concept of 'perspective' drawing. They will soon go onto creating a print, using a chosen part of their drawing.
