

Pastoral Care



St. Bede's is an orderly, well-disciplined community where learning flourishes. Excellent behaviour plays a major part in our continued success.

The pastoral system is the bedrock of our school and is based on high behavioural standards, mutual respect and a true level of dedication towards students from our compassionate staff.

All Year 7 students are assigned to a tutor group within a House structure which they will remain in until Year 11. This group is a mixed-ability group made up of students from different primary schools. Siblings are placed in the same House to allow the Heads of House to form long lasting relationships and get to know families as the first point of home school contact.

Developing the whole student

Throughout these five years students will experience personal, social and health education. These weekly sessions cover:

- Spiritual development: Providing students with an opportunity to help develop a real and lasting relationship with God.
- Relationship development: Exploring what is understood as authentic human love and the dignity of each person.
- Social development: Developing our students' social skills, self-awareness and personal wellbeing.
- Careers development: Providing impartial advice and unleashing student ambitions for their future.
- Learning development: Acquiring the skills of an effective lifelong learner.

We know that parents and carers play a vital role in children's learning, so we regularly ask them for their opinions and feedback to ensure they're working with us as full partners.



Transport arrangements

All of our students who live more than 2 miles from school in our feeder areas travel on dedicated school transport to and from school.

This is without cost to parents and is regardless of faith. We believe in supporting families to access the best education for children, rather than just the closest one.

St. Bede's – a school where success and potential of each individual is recognised and a will to achieve is actively encouraged.


We provide a broad and balanced curriculum which aims to:

- Develop students lively, enquiring minds; to help them enjoy the
 acquisition of knowledge; promote the ability to question and argue
 rationally; to better understand technology, science and
 mathematics; to enhance the use of information technology across
 the curriculum; to encourage students to apply themselves to a
 range of tasks and skills which will equip them for their life in a
 technological future and as Christian adults.
- Enable students to use language and numbers effectively; to appreciate and respond creatively through the variety of learning experiences offered to them by all areas of the curriculum.

We provide a curriculum rich in opportunities, recognising that each student is unique and has different talents and gifts. The curriculum provides students with the skills and knowledge which will allow them go onto a range of GCSE, A level and selected applied courses. We are highly ambitious for our young people and every student who is appropriate for the EBACC suite of qualifications is entered.

Students are set by ability from KS2 prior attainment, and reassessed across their 5 year academic career. Students are set aspirational targets in order to make sure that they push themselves to fulfil their God given potential. In order to realise this goal we know how important it is to work with parents, keeping them informed and working as a team to maximise student success.

We are a forward thinking school, always seeking to futureproof our offer and to find new and creative ways to allow young people to develop a zest for learning.

We use fresh ingredients to prepare healthy and nutritionally balanced meals each day. The majority of our menus are homemade by our chefs in our kitchens.


Staff are trained to accommodate medical diets and work in partnership with parents to ensure these needs are met. As part of the Trust's commitment to sustainability, we regularly review food miles and continue to work to reduce food waste.

Parents/Carers can pay for school meals using ParentPay, and can view meal choices and account balance online. This operates via a biometric (finger scanning) process, improving efficiency and removing the need for cash.

Students entitled to free meals are allowed to purchase food to the value of a free school meal allowance daily. Students also have the option to bring a packed lunch (nuts or nut-based products aren't permitted). Find out more:
