English

We will write for a variety of purposes this term focusing on themes of interest and that link to other curriculum areas.. Children will use WAGOLLS, shared writing and editing to help improve their writing skills.

Maths

Using the White Rose Maths Scheme, this term we will focus on the Place Value of numbers and securing and extending our knowledge. The 4 number operations of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division will also be key objectives. We hope to also begin our Fractions work.

R.E

Our three topics we will explore this term are: Loving, Vocation & Commitments and Expectations. Pupils will consider how Christian belief impacts on actions and children will be encouraged to make links between scripture and life.

Science

Topics this term have a biology focus - Living Things and Animals and Humans were we will study human circulatory system, and describe the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood.

History/ Geography

History we will learn about WW1 and links to Hartlepool. Geography will be looking at Climate Change.

ICT

This term we will investigate and discuss online safety and its importance. Coding knowledge will also be extended learning how to debug and create games.

Music

We will look at the genres of Pop/Motown, Jazz, Latin, Blues.

PSHE
