

Geography

This term our topic is called 'Where I Live'. We will explore our local area and compare the features to Brazil. We will learn about physical and human features, map reading, key symbols, the UK countries and the 7 continents of the world.

ICT

We will explore Grouping and Sorting and Pictograms using Purple Mash.

Art

In art, we will be exploring our sculpture through the creation of vibrant and expressive carnival masks, linking our artistic learning to our Geography topic on Brazil. We will explore form, texture and colour to construct our own unique masks.

Literacy (Writing)

We will begin this term using the story 'The Tiger Who Came to Tea' and will focus on description, instructions, letters/postcards and invitations. We will then focus on stories from other cultures/worlds.

In reading, we are using various texts within our reading route, focusing on the reading domains of comprehension, vocabulary, sequencing and retrieval.

Non-fiction texts will also be linked to our Geography and Science topics!

Spellings - We will continue to learn spellings from our Sounds Write sessions and the statutory spelling lists which will be tested on a Friday as part of our spelling quiz!

PE (Tuesday and Friday)

Invasion games - Dodgeball. We will be focusing on the ball control, passing, throwing and catching and applying the rules and these skills within simple games.

Floor gymnastics - we will explore travelling, balances, rolls and jumps and linking these movements into a performance.

Music

We will be learning to sing and play instruments along to the Charanga unit 'In the Groove.'


SCIENCE

We will investigate the biology strand of Animals including Humans where we identify and name a variety of common animals, sort them using their animal groups, identify carnivores, herbivores and omnivores, describe and compare their structures. We will identify, name and label the basic parts of the human body and the parts for our senses.

Using the White Rose Maths Scheme:
We will continue working on our Subtraction skills within 10 and 2D and 3D Shapes.

We will then continue to work on our Place Value, Addition and Subtraction within 20 and Measuring length, height, mass and volume.

RE

We will explore the topic called Special People where we look at how the people in our parish family help us at church. The big question is **What makes a person special?** We will then explore the topic called Meals where we will look at the Last Supper and Communion at Mass. Our big question is **What makes some meals special?** Our Lent/Easter is called Change where the children explore the signs, symbols and stories around Holy Week. Our big question is **How and why do things change?** Finally, our last topic is Pentecost: Holidays and Holy Days with the big question **Do we need Holidays and Holidays?**
