### What we will learn

### RE

To begin with the children will explore the topics of people (Y4) and ourselves (Y5) as part of the domestic church unit. Towards the end of the term we will be exploring advent and preparing for Christmas.

#### **PSHF**

In PSHE we will look at The Sacraments (Y4), story sessions, emotional wellbeing, respecting our bodies (Y4), online safety and lots more.

### Maths

This term we will begin by looking closely at place value, focusing on numbers to 10,000 (Y4) and 1,000,000 (Y5). Then we will move onto addition and subtraction before looking at multiplication and division. Regular times table practice will continue to take place and accessing Times Table Rock Stars continues to be important.

# Literacy

We will be following our writing journey. We will look at different forms of writing such as poetry, instructional writing and cultural narratives.

Exploring the different sentence structures to build on our understanding, we will also use carefully chosen texts to support our ideas and planning before writing our own pieces.

### Science

This term both Year 4 and Year 5 will be covering the topics of 'living things' and 'animals including humans'. To begin we will explore the 7 life processes (Y4) and life cycles and reproduction (Y5). We will also plan and carry out investigations.

### What we will learn

### History

In History we will be learning about the Anglo Saxons, Scots and Viking Britain, with a local link of St Hilda's. We will learn why the Anglo Saxons invaded Britain and settled here, and children will discover the many changes that took place in the North East. Children will learn to think like an Historian and discuss their thoughts.

### Δrt

For the first half term we will be looking at the topic of painting. We will be exploring different techniques to follow our theme of 'illuminated letters' and discovering artists along the way.

### PE

On Monday we will be learning all the skills needed to play our invasion game, tag rugby. Building on our throwing and catching skills.

On Thursdays we will be developing our dance skills.
