Our attendance figures however are impacted by those children whose attendance is not good, particularly those that fall into the Persistent Absence category (PA = 90% or below) The good news however, is that due to everyone's hard work, our school's PA has reduced from 27.5% (Summer 23) to 23.3% (Autumn 23) and now to 16.8%. (Spring 24) We are committed to supporting our families by removing barriers to good attendance, but will continue to challenge poor attendance to ensure our children are given the best opportunities and start to life.

Rewards: As you know, good attendance is rewarded every Friday during our whole school achievement assembly. Each class works as a team to earn attendance money which they can save up across the year. As a class they can decide how and when to spend it and celebrate their achievement together. PUNCTUALITY-DID YOU KNOW?

Missing just 10 minutes of school a day is the same as missing 6 days over the year. 6 days of lost learning and opportunities!

Punctuality is very important, so arriving late or leaving early is not good for your child. School is where we learn good habits for the rest of our lives. We need your help to support this.
