








Class 3 Half-Termly letter Autumn

This newsletter informs you of the topics we will be covering this half term and gives some suggestions on how you can support your child with their learning.

Subject	What we are learning	What you can do to help your child at home
 <p>Religious Education And RSE (Relationships and Sex Education)</p>	<p>In RE, we will be focussing on the topic 'New Beginnings'. Our Big Question will be 'Who made the world and everything in it?'.</p>	<p>Talk to your child about their learning. Can the children retell the creation of God?</p> <p>Help your child to understand the concepts taught and how they can use what they have learnt in their daily lives.</p>
	<p>This term children will focus on the place value of numbers within 100, grouping two-digit numbers into tens and ones. They will be partitioning, comparing and ordering numbers. Children will count in 2s, 5s, 10s and 3s.</p>	<p>Support your child in recalling the times tables they have learnt.</p>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Describing the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene. 	
	<p>This term the children will learn what a monarch is, who our current monarch is and how they become King or Queen.</p> <p>They will be comparing monarchs through time, describing aspects of each Queen's reign and aspects of life in Elizabethan and Victorian England and recognising similarities and differences.</p>	<p>Ask your child what they have been learning this week. What questions do they have? Can you help them find the answers through research? Encourage children to discuss their findings.</p>
	<p>This term we are focussing on:</p> <p>Tuesday – Multi skills. Friday – Dance.</p>	<p>Our PE days are Tuesday and Friday. Please ensure your child has their PE kit in school.</p>
	<p>To begin with, children will complete the 'Online Safety' unit before moving onto 'Coding'.</p>	<p>Children can log on to their purple mash at home and practice their skills.</p>
