We will be moving in different ways e.g. crawling, rolling, sliding etc.

There will be a range of mark-making activities for the children to access such as drawing, whiteboards, sand area and junk modelling.

Children will write their names daily encouraging the children to hold their pencil between their first two fingers and thumb and use it with good control.

Play a game to move around the house in different ways.

Create your own pictures and artwork at home. Put pictures on seesaw for us to see and your child can talk to their friends about this.

Encourage your child to write their names at home focussing on their letter formation and how they hold their pencil/pen.





We will continue to use our daily timetable, so the children understand what is happening now and next.

We will be using our nursery bear which a child can take home and show what they do at home on a weekend.


We will be discussing how humans can grow and how we have grown over time.

Talk to your child about what you will do today or things you may see on your way to school.

When you have the nursery bear, encourage your child to show the bear where they live, what is their favourite toy and who lives in their family.

Show pictures of your child as a baby and how they have grown over time.
