

REWARDS

- **GOLDEN TIME:**

On a weekly basis children will take part, in their classrooms, in a *GOLDEN TIME* session.

- **RAFFLE TICKETS:**

Children are rewarded in classrooms with tickets. These tickets are then brought to a weekly celebration assembly. If a child's name is drawn from their class box, they choose a small prize from the 'Dip in the box.'

- **TOKENS:**

Tokens are given by all members of staff to any child that they see living out our mission of 'Loving one another' for example holding a door, great manners etc. These tokens are then placed in their class jar - the class with the most tokens at the end of the term is rewarded with a shared class reward for example, pizza and a movie after school or a visit to the beach.

- **POSTCARD HOME:**

A postcard from the Headteacher will be posted to 1 child per class every half term. This could be sent for a variety of positive reasons.

- **STAR OF THE WEEK**

Each class will award a class Star of the Week.

- **HOT CHOCOLATE FRIDAY**

Children will be chosen each week from their class to share in a hot chocolate treat with the Headteacher.

CONSEQUENCES

This will be as follows:

Step 1 - a reminder for disruptive behaviour

Step 2 - a warning (this leads to 5 minutes of the following break time being missed)

Step 3 - a red card (this will lead to missing all the next break time, during which time a Think Sheet is to be completed, reflecting on their own behaviour). Parents will receive a phone-call from a member of staff and informed about this.

Step 4 - 2 red cards in a week will result in the child missing Golden Time.

An immediate red card may be issued if behaviour or actions displayed are deemed to be of a serious, inappropriate or concerning nature.

NB - participation in Golden Time can also be decided at each teacher's discretion.

A build-up of 7 or more red cards over a term would result in the child missing any planned school trips or events and/or may result in the need to escalation through behaviour policy stages. Two red cards in any after school club would result in the child being excluded from that club for the rest of the term.

****For a build-up of incidents, or serious incidents, the school will follow the behaviour policy as they see fit.****
