What's been happening in School this week?

Year 6 have completed the novel 'A Christmas Carol' by Charles Dickens, and produced some fantastic writing about the character of Scrooge. We are excited to watch the film version! In Maths they have been learning BODMAS, so we fully understand the order of operations in calculations. We have completed our work on the human body in Science by discussing the ways we can keep our body safe and healthy. They are also still learning about the History of Preston Docks in Topic

Year 5 have been completing their end of term assessments this week and have worked their socks off! We have also been creating calendars, making Personal Improvement Promises and continuing our work in R.E. working on a modernised version of The Ten Commandments.

Year 4 have worked very hard. They have been completing Maths and English assessments and have done really well. They have also been creating Christmas quizzes for them to take part in next week. They enjoyed an RE lesson where they looked at a crib and focused on the key figures within the nativity story. In French they have also written a letter to Father Christmas using their French vocabulary. They have also really enjoyed practising and recording their two songs for the Christmas reflection.

Penguins have completed their persuasive letters to Father Christmas this week. In Maths the older children have worked really hard on their column addition. They've also been looking at key events in the nativity story in preparation for making illustrations from Play-Doh next week
