- Make appropriate use of school apps (such as DoJo) and social media sites ensuring all comments concerning school are appropriate and respectful.

- ✓ Co-operate in class by doing his/her best work and taking part in all class activities
- ✓ Work and move around the classroom and school quietly and carefully trying not to disturb others
- Be aware of the needs of others and treat everyone with kindness and respect both in and out of school
- Listen to adults and other children and speak to them politely and respectfully
- Respect and care for all property, books, equipment and articles of clothing
- ✓ Be reliable, punctual and wear the school uniform
