# News

School re-opening from next Monday, 22<sup>nd</sup> June

On Monday we very excited to welcome back children from Years R, 1 & 6 as well as "Key worker" children from our other year groups.

This is a step in the right direction & we have had lots of questions surrounding this - here are some of our responses:

- Whilst we are doing a great deal to minimise risks - we CANNOT provide 2m social distancing at all times in school - especially not with the younger children but will do our utmost to try.
- Arrival & Pick up times, already specified, **MUST** be adhered to. If you have children in different bubbles & do not wish to wait then our Drop off facility is available from 8:20am at a cost of £1.50 however this **MUST** be booked in advance.

- Parents who decide not to send their children back initially still have the option of returning at a later date providing they give school a **week's notice & the return date will be Monday.**
- "Key worker" children may continue to attend on "shift" days & can be collected before 2:25pm or at their allotted time of 3:00 pm.
- Children from the Years R, 1 & 6 must attend school every day.
- School uniform must be worn – a minimum of school trousers, skirt or dress with white shirt, polo shirt, school shoes or trainers.
- Please do not bring extra bags or anything from home into school
- Your child will be in a "bubble" with the same staff each day but this may not be your child's class teacher
- Your child may not be with their usual friends or be allowed to play with children from other bubbles
- REMEMBER – do not park on or come near the yellow lines outside school or block driveways.
- Dinners – you child may bring a packed lunch or have a school dinner – this is next week's menu
