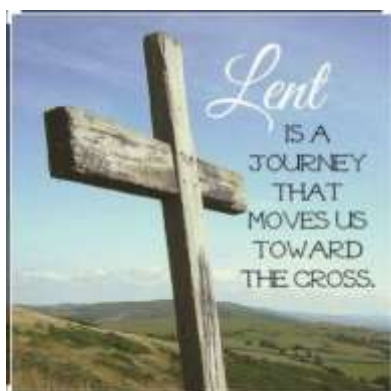


Dates for your Diary

Lateral Flow Testing for households, Support Bubbles and Childcare Bubbles of Pupils and Staff

As I am sure you will be aware the Government have a testing system in place within schools. At present within Primary Schools only staff have been invited to engage with twice weekly Lateral Flow Testing (LFT). The Government has now extended the testing to families of Primary aged pupils. If you're a member of a household, childcare bubble or support bubble of staff or a pupil you can get a twice-weekly test: • through your employer if they offer testing to employees • at a local test site • by collecting a home test kit from a test site • by ordering a home test kit online. At present, as a school, we do not have any facilities to provide kits to families.

PLEASE NOTE - LFT tests (Lateral Flow Tests) do not replace the need for a PCR tests (polymerase chain reaction) test and should your child or a member of the household or Bubbles develop symptoms families must still isolate and seek a test
