If you know anyone who would like to attend our Nursery from September 2021 please ask them to contact school as places are filling up. We take children from 3 years old & funding is available from the term after the child turns 3.

Children who are eligible for free school meals will receive a £15 voucher for over the May half term holiday.

Over the last few months we have been less strict about school uniform. Shops were closed, life was stressful enough for many families without having to worry about uniform and life was anything but normal.

**From 14<sup>th</sup> June we will be expecting school uniform policy to be adhered to - particularly in the following areas:**

**PE kits** Many children are coming to school on PE days in general sports/casual wear. This is not our PE uniform.

**For the infants** the PE uniform is currently the normal school uniform top and sweat shirt with black joggers or black PE shorts (not cycling shorts) and dark trainers. The joggers or shorts should be plain and unbranded where possible.

The PE uniform for **key stage 2** is a red plain T-shirt / polo shirt, school jumper, black joggers/shorts and trainers - not cycling shorts.

**Ear-rings** - ear rings should not be worn in school. We understand that there is a period of time when a child needs to keep them in after they have their ears pierced. Plasters may be worn over the ear-rings for a period of time. However this is a limited time and after this children should not be wearing ear-rings to school.
