When we return on 14th June we will be expecting school uniform policy to be adhered to - particularly in the following areas:

<u>PE kits</u> Many children are coming to school on PE days in general sports/casual wear. This is not our PE uniform.

For the infants the PE uniform is currently the normal school uniform top and sweat shirt with black joggers or black PE shorts (not cycling shorts) and dark trainers. The joggers or shorts should be plain and unbranded where possible.

The PE uniform for **key stage 2** is a red plain T-shirt / polo shirt, school jumper, black joggers/shorts and trainers – not cycling shorts.

Ear-rings - ear rings should not be worn in school. We understand that there is a period of time when a child needs to keep them in after they have their ears pierced. Plasters may be worn over the ear-rings for a period of time. However this is a limited time and after this children should not be wearing ear-rings to school.

Toast is now available to pay for in readiness for June – please ensure this is paid before we return as it will be taken off ParentPay on Monday $14^{\rm th}$ June.

A message went out this week to all parents about **Judo**. This will start on Friday 18^{th} June & will run for 5 weeks. The cost is £26. Please complete details on the APP & pay on ParentPay.
