We have fantastic environments, both indoor and outdoor to enrich children's learning and development.



Continuous provision allows the children to learn through play, explore, experiment, discover and solve problems in imaginative and playful ways based on their own interests.



A mixture of child-led and adult-initiated activities ensures children develop their speaking and listening, social skills and independence.

Parents / Carers may use their 15 hour (universal entitlement) & the 30 hours (extended entitlement) for working parents of 3 & 4 year olds.

The Nursery hours are from 8:45 am - 3:15 pm and is term time only. We also provide extended care before and after the school day -in line with our current "wrap-around" school arrangements - 7:30am until 6:00pm



Tapestry



During their time in nursery, the children's learning and development will be tracked using an online learning journal called Tapestry. This enables staff to take photos/videos and written observations of the activities they do in nursery and share them with parents. Parents are also able to add their own photos and comments to their child's learning journey to enable a shared partnership for children's development.
