



Pupil Worry Box & Drop In Session.

Parents and Carers. My name is Leigh Robertson and I am an "Emotional Health & Wellbeing Practitioner". I work for a children's charity called "Child Action North West" I have worked in primary schools in Preston, Chorley and Blackburn for 10years. My role in school is to support pupils with a wide range of topics.

I will be running a "Pupil Drop In" at school on a Monday lunchtime, 12midday until 1pm in The Sparkle Den. Pupils can come and talk to me about any worries or problems they might be experiencing. These could be about their friendships, school work or home and family.

The children come to talk to me and we try and think of ways that we can resolve their issues. The Drop In is confidential, however I will always update teaching staff and contact parents directly if the children speak with me about anything that might put themselves or others at risk.

If you feel that your child may benefit from having a chat with me, please speak with your child's class teacher or with Mrs. Sutton or Mrs. Barlow. The Drop In will rotate around each different Year Group every week, starting with Year 6

If you DO NOT want your child to be part of the drop in, please let your child's class teacher know.
