### Key Vocabulary and grammar

I can say a few sentences about myself.  
I can use les or des with plural nouns.  
I can describe things using simple adjectives.

### Key Listening Skills

Pick out familiar words and phrases from spoken sentences  
Recognise familiar words and phrases in a spoken story or poem.  
Identify the gender of a noun from the article  
Understand short sentence instructions and follow them .  
Recognise who is being talked about from the pronoun.  
Recognise that the structure of some French sentences differs from English



### Reading in French

Read a simple rhyme or poem aloud  
Follow and understand a familiar text.  
Use a bi-lingual dictionary to look up the meaning in English of unfamiliar French words.  
Use a bi-lingual dictionary to find the French translation of English words.  
I can understand the difference between le/la and un/une. I can recognise the meaning of mon,/ma/ mes.  
I can recognise subject pronouns.  
I can recognise the first, second and third person singular forms of some common verbs

### French Writing

Write responses to spoken language using short phrase and simple sentences.  
I can express my opinion using simple sentences.  
I can write some phrases/sentences from memory  
I can write a few simple sentences about myself from memory/  
I write the correct article for the gender of a noun  
I can write the correct form of some common verbs
