PAID DINNERS

If your child has paid school meals, please ensure their dinner balance is topped up weekly on ParentMail. If your child's dinner balance is not kept up to date, you'll be asked to move them on to packed lunches.

BREAKFAST CLUB TIMES

Please note, if you book your child in to breakfast club from 7:00am you must arrive at 7:00am or after. If you book your child in from 8:00am you must NOT arrive before 8:00am. The cut off for your child to have breakfast is 8:20am.

COATS AND JACKETS

All children should come to school with a coat or a jacket in the colder, winter months.
