Both children will receive a prize from Egremont Town Council at the Egremont Winter Wonderland on Sunday 27th November.



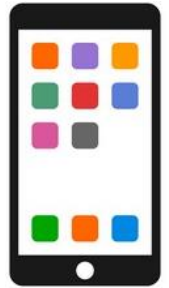
NAMES IN UNIFORM
