EASTER JAR COMPETITION 2023

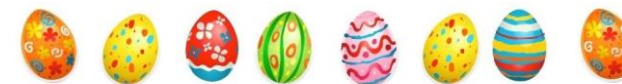

Punctuality

MOBILE PHONES IN SCHOOL
Children are NOT allowed to bring/have mobile phones on the school premises, even if your child walks home from school.

NAMES IN UNIFORM
Remember to put your child's name in their uniform, that way if something goes missing we are able to locate the missing uniform.

PARKING
Please can parents/carers be respectful of the residents, especially where you park when dropping off or collecting your child from school and nursery. Please do not block drives or park on double yellow lines/zig zag lines outside school.

PAID DINNERS
If your child has paid school meals, please ensure their dinner balance is topped up weekly on ParentMail. If your child's dinner balance is not kept up to date, you'll be asked to move them on to packed lunches.

BREAKFAST CLUB TIMES
Please note, if you book your child in to breakfast club from 7:00am you must arrive at 7:00am or after. If you book your child in from 8:00am you must **NOT** arrive before 8:00am. The cut off for your child to have breakfast is 8:20am.

COATS AND JACKETS
All children should come to school with a coat or a jacket in the colder, winter months.



DINNER ORDERING
Dinner ordering forms are sent out at the start of each week for the following week. You **MUST** complete the form with your child. The deadline for completion is every Friday at 12 noon. If you do not order your child's dinner for the week they will be given the hot option, without choice. You and your child must pick the choices together as we've had multiple incidents where children do not want what has been chosen for them.
