# Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Begins to make new friends and play alongside others
- Is starting to develop the awareness of how their actions affect others
- Can say what things they like and dislike.

## **Communication and Language**

- Can listen to stories of their interest
- Is able to talk about things that they can see in their local area
- Can talk about themselves and their family
- Develops new vocabulary linked to the topic.
- Begins to ask own questions

## **Physical Development**

- Can move and climb confidently when outside
- Beginning to show more control with their pencil grip and mark making
- Become more independent with tasks such as putting their own coat on and shoes

- Joins in with their favourite songs and nursery rhymes
- Chooses their favourite stories to share
- Can give meaning to what they mark make and describe pictures that they draw such as self portraits

#### Maths

- Can say number names in order
- Begins to use language such as more or lots when comparing
- Can look at patterns
- Begins to use positional language when looking at maps and our local area

- Are able to say how they are different or the same as others
- In RE can they can talk about what makes them special
- Can talk about who is in their family
- Can play with small world toys using their own experiences in play
- Becomes more independent when using ICT equipment
- Has their own friends

- Sings their favourite songs
- Use instruments to make different noises
- Beginning to experiment with colours
- Can make believe about their own experiences at home in the home corner
