School Dinners

The cost of a school lunch is £13.75 per week. Parents can choose their children's lunch and pay in advance by using Schoolmoney.

All lunches need to be booked and paid for by Sunday to allow the cook to prepare the meals. A packed lunch brought into school needs to have a balanced healthy content (please see our Food Policy).

We receive free fruit or vegetables every day for the children in Foundation Unit and Key Stage 1as part of the 'Free Fruit and Vegetables for Schools Scheme'. If children in Key Stage 2 would like fruit it costs £1.00 per week. We are also part of the subsidised milk scheme. One third of a pint is currently available at a cost of £1 per week for every child. Children who are in the Foundation class receive the milk free until the beginning of the half term after they are 5 years old. As a school we subsidise this, so that children can have milk free throughout the EYFS years. We also encourage the drinking of plain water regularly throughout the day.
