- 1. Prioritise 'disciplinary literacy' across the curriculum
- 2. Provide targeted vocabulary instruction in every subject
- 3. Develop students' ability to read complex academic texts
- 4. Break down complex writing tasks
- 5. Combine writing instruction with reading in every subject
- 6. Provide opportunities for structured talk
