

RE



In RE we are studying the topic Galilee to Jerusalem.

We will learn about key events in Jesus' life through the stories of The Presentation and Jesus in the Temple, exploring the key messages. We will look at how Jesus carried out his mission to set people free and how we should try to be like Jesus.

English



We will be developing reading skills through daily phonics lessons. We will develop the skills needed to write simple words and sentences. Inspired by Handa's Surprise, Anna Hibiscus Song, Nilkwei's day and Fatou fetch the water we will write stories, letters, instructions and information texts.

Maths

In maths we will develop our mathematical skills and knowledge through the units Place Value, addition and subtraction, length and height and mass and volume. We will use concrete apparatus and practical activities to explore and develop our skills alongside recording our learning in different ways.

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Science

In Science we will study animals and their habitats. We will investigate which animals live in habitats in school grounds. We will explore other habitats such as deserts, polar and oceans. We will make simple food chains and think how animals can live in each area



History

In History we will study Amelia Earhart. We will discover why she was famous and how this has impacted on our lives today. We will order events on a timeline and use evidence to find out about the past.



Computing

In computing we will be learning about technology all around us. We will discover what technology is and how we can use it safely and responsibly to help us. We will develop our mouse and keyboard skills using laptops, learning how to create, store and retrieve our work.

Music

In Music we will be listening and learning songs and sounds. We will move to the music and explore playing instruments. Our topics are called 'Me' and 'My stories'.



Geography



In Geography we will be studying Africa. We will explore where Africa is on a map and globe. We will find out about different animals and how they can survive in Africa. We will explore African landscapes and foods and compare these to where we live.

P.E

In P.E this half term we will be focussing on the ball skills. We will be rolling, throwing and catching a range of equipment and then using our skills to play simple games. We will also develop our gymnastics skills of balancing and rolling.



RSE

We will be following the Ten Ten Resources module on Created to Love others. We will study the story of the prodigal son. We will discuss who our special people are and talk about forgiveness and saying sorry. We will learn how to keep safe online and how to look after our bodies.
