

## RE

In RE we are studying the topic Galilee to Jerusalem.

We will explore Jesus' ministry and the way he taught us to live, through the beatitudes and the signs that Jesus worked in John's Gospel including the feeding of the 5000, the wedding feast of Cana, raising Lazarus from the dead and the healing at the pool.

## English

We will be developing our comprehension skills each day through VIPERS. We will write a variety of genres using our novels as a stimulus. We will write a range of fiction and non-fiction pieces.

We will be reading The Titanic Detective Agency and Romeo and Juliet

## Maths

In maths we will be learning to multiply and divide. We will be calculating with fractions, decimals and percentages. We will be converting between units and solving perimeter, area and volume problems. We will learn how to draw line graphs and solve statistical problems. We will learn how to use ratio and algebra.

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## Science

In Science we will study Animals, including Humans, we will focus on describing the ways in which nutrients and water are transported within animals, including humans. We will be identifying the main parts of the human circulatory system, and describing the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood. We will study the impact of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle on the way our bodies function. We will then study the topic of Light

## Art and D.T

In Art we will be studying the Mayan art on their masks. We will develop our painting and colour skills and creating our own Mayan artwork

In DT we will be developing our sewing and textile skills.



## Spanish

In Spanish we will be becoming fluent in vocabulary and sentences relating to our families.



## History

In History we will study the ancient Mayans. We will identify the chronology of the Mayans, explore and compare their society and power. We will learn about their religion, art and artefacts. We will also explore how the ancient beliefs impacted and influenced their everyday life. We will then form opinions and judgements about how the civilisation declined.



## Computing

In computing we will be learning to complete vector drawings and use code programs. In computing we will be learning about e-safety and staying safe online. We will also explore how computer systems work.



## Music

In Music we will be listening and appraising songs and sounds. We will then use these skills to create compositions. Our topics are called 'Living on a Prayer' and Classroom Jazz.



## Geography



In Geography we will be studying North America. We will identify the geographical and physical features of the USA including the Grand Canyon. We will then explore the physical challenges facing North America and the impact farming has on the country. We will then compare New York to other American cities to see how it has changed over time.

## P.E

In P.E this half term we will be focussing on the skills of resilience, teamwork, outdoor activity through Forest School. We will also study partner work in gymnastics and Indian dance.



## RSE

We will be following the Ten Ten Resources module on Personal Relationships to equip children with strategies for more complex experiences of relationships and conflict. After half term, the focus will be Keeping Safe, equipping children to make safe and sensible decisions about what online content they should/shouldn't share, and strategies to avoid cyberbullying.
