Just a quick reminder about our uniform policy:

- grey school shorts
- black shoes (not trainers or high heels)
- navy blue jumper or cardigan
- no earrings
- hair tied up

### <u>Letters</u>

At St. Chad's, we are always looking for ways to help the environment.

We are trying to reduce the amount of paper we use.

Therefore, most of the letters which we send home this year (unless they require a signature) will be sent electronically.

### <u>Attendance</u>

There is a clear link between attendance and achievement therefore it is very important that your child attends school every day unless they are unwell or there are exceptional circumstances. Appointments should be made out of school time where possible please.

Punctuality is extremely important. Children are required to be at school by 9am. Our core subject lessons (English and Maths) begin immediately after registration. If you child is late, they will miss vital bits of learning which will impact on their overall academic progress.

The Department for Education deems that if a child's attendance drops below 90% they become known as a Persistent Absentee. All absences are monitored thoroughly.

Below are the percentages of attendance for each class for September:

Class 1 - 99%

Class 2- 95%

Class 3- 90%

Class 4 - 93%

### PE Days

Class 1 - Monday/Tuesday

Class 2- Thursday/Friday

Class 3- Friday

Class 4 - Wednesday

Class 1 and 2- PE kits will be kept at school and children will get changed at school.

**Class 3 and 4-** Please can children come to school dressed in their jogging bottoms/shorts (black or navy), trainers, white t-shirt and school jumper/cardigan.

Class 3 and 4- If your child is attending an after-school PE club, please can they come to school in uniform and bring their kit in a bag to get changed into.

# **Breakfast Club**

Our breakfast club runs from **7.50am** every morning for £2. Please can children be accompanied until **7.50am**.

A selection of breakfast items (including cereal, toast, fruit) are on offer.

A range of activities and games (including lego, k'nex, colouring in) are on offer too.

# After-School Club

Our after-school club runs from **3.10pm until 5.10pm every evening**. Children can be picked up any time between these times – up to 4.10pm is £2, after 4.10pm is £4.

A range of activities and games (including outdoor activities, puzzles, board games) are on offer.

Drinks and snacks are also included.

### Parking Outside School

The safety of our children is paramount; we kindly ask that you refrain from parking on the yellow zig zag lines and in the bus stop when dropping off and collecting children from our school.

The Highway Code states that you should keep these areas clear of stationary vehicles even if picking up or setting down children.



### Staff Car Park

When dropping off (including breakfast club) and picking up your child (including after school clubs), please can the main gate in the front playground be used.

We kindly ask that you refrain from walking through the staff car park.

The safety of our children and families is our top priority.
