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After-school care

Please don't forget that our after-school care is available to all. We have spaces for regular care or even the occasional day if you have to work late or work shifts. The children thoroughly enjoy the sessions as it is very relaxed where they can play games both indoors and outdoors, enjoy different crafts and much more.

There are two sessions available:

Session 1: 3:15-4:45 £4.50 per child (If your child attends an after school-club, the cost for the remainder of the session will be £2)

Session 2: 3:15-5:45 £6 per child (this also includes a sandwich and fruit. If your child attends an after- school club, the cost for the remainder of the session will be £4)

10% discount will be given for siblings and payments can be made via your child's ScoPay account.

Please note from Monday 7th November if your child is not collected by 3:25pm (10 minutes after the end of the school day) they will be placed into after school care for session 1 and this will be charged to your ScoPay account.







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Reminders....

Earrings- lots of children have had their ears pierced. Please make sure they are covered on PE days. If not, we will call you and ask you to bring a plaster to school.

Snacks – there have been an increasing number of chocolate bars and crisps brought in as snacks. We are a healthy school please give your children fruit or cereal bars. Any crisps or sugary snacks will be sent home.

School meals to packed lunch – please can you let the office know in advance if your child would like to change from school meals to packed lunch and vice versa as the kitchen require some notice to adjust orders.

Car Parking – Please continue to park on the school grounds! Some of our neighbours have contacted with me with footage of cars across their drives. They have also sent them to the local authority as some footage shows illegal parking.

Reporting absences – It is vital that you call school if your child is going to be absent. Please contact the office before 8:55am providing a reason for your child's absence.

Payments – Please can you ensure any remaining debts from your Scopay account are cleared as soon as possible. If you need a link for Scopay please contact the office. Thank you for contributions towards trips, if you have not added a contribution for your child's trip this will be shown on your Scopay account to be paid before the end of term.
