
Friends of St Charles

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Sports News



After-school care and Breakfast club.

Both our breakfast club and after school club can now be booked online. You can book up to 5 sessions at one time.

The cost of breakfast club is £2. It starts at 7:45 and the children will receive a choice of toast, cereals and fruit.

There are two sessions available:

Session 1: 3:15-4:45 £4.50 per child (If your child attends an after schoolclub, the cost for the remainder of the session will be £2)

Session 2: 3:15-5:45 £6 per child (this also includes a sandwich and fruit. If your child attends an after- school club, the cost for the remainder of the session will be £4)

10% discount will be given for siblings and payments can be made via your child's ScoPay account.

Please note from Monday 7th November if your child is not collected by 3:25pm (10 minutes after the end of the school day) they will be placed into after school care for session 1 and this will be charged to your ScoPay account.

Reminders....

Earrings- lots of children have had their ears pierced. Please make sure they are covered on PE days. If not we will call you and ask you to bring a plaster to school.
