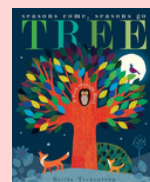

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

- Settling in building relationships and understanding our feelings.
- Recognising and talking about different emotions
- Learning how to be a kind friend and take turns.
- Exploring simple strategies to manage strong feelings and worries.
- Creating a classroom feelings toolbox



Communication and Language

- Talking about ourselves, our likes and dislikes.
- Listening carefully during stories and group times.
- Learning new vocabulary and using it in play.
- Taking turns in conversation.
- Asking for help and following simple instructions.



Physical Development

- PE- Moving safely, Running, Jumping, Balancing, travelling and obstacle course
- Developing hand strength, coordination and control
- Using tools and materials to build fine motor skills ready to write.



Literacy

- Exploring stories and books in our environment
- Learning how to handle books carefully
- Exploring mark making with different tools
- Talking about pictures in books and sharing ideas
- Developing early writing skills through play



Maths

- Getting to know our classroom routines and key times of day.
- Matching and sorting objects
- Comparing groups of objects
- Comparing size and identify bigger and smaller
- Noticing patterns in our environment



Understanding the world

- Exploring our amazing bodies and what they can do.
- Learning about our families and how they grow and change.
- Exploring our school community and local area.
- Finding out about people who help us and how to stay safe.
- Notice changes in the autumn season.



Expressive art and design

- Creating self portrait and exploring colour, texture and shape.
- Exploring music, singing and movement and instrument
- Developing imaginative play and role play
- Creating autumn art using natural materials
- Building constructing and making with a variety of resources

How you can help at home



- Read stories together every day and talk about the pictures.
- Talk about family and who is special to you.
- Explore your local area - go for a walk and notice buildings, shops and places.
- Encourage independence with dressing, hand washing and tidying up.
- Talk about feelings and encourage your child to share what makes them happy or worried.
- Look for signs of autumn and talk about the changes in the season.
