Listening to stories, Whole Class Reading and Phonics

We will be learning:

- to blend sounds for reading words
- that one sound can have different spellings
- one sound is sometimes represented by two letters
- about key stories.



Writing

Writing to Inform | Writing to entertain

We will be learning about:

- using all of the space across the line,
- saying sentences aloud before writing,
- segmenting to spell using phonics,
- leaving spaces between words,
- letter formation and handwriting
- writing dictated sentences.



Maths

Number – Place Value | Number – addition and subtraction

We will be learning about:

- counting forwards and backwards,
- counting one more and one less,
- comparing numbers,
- estimating numbers on a number line,
- exploring the structure of numbers up to at least 20.



Science

The Human Body

We will be learning about:

- our bodies and our senses,
- eyes and sight,
- ears and hearing,
- touch, taste and smell,
- understanding sensory impairment.



Computing

Technology Around Us

We will be learning about:

- recognising technology around us,
- using technology responsibly.

- the pulse being the steady heartbeat of the music,
- the difference between the pulse and rhythm
