- Use AIR (accountable, independent reading).

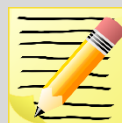


Writing

- The Jewish concept of 'repentance'

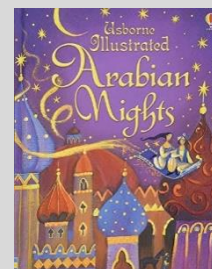
