Writing Activities:

- Practise handwriting using your common exception words.
- Draw your own comic strip using capital letters and full stops.
- Spend 5 minutes each day writing a diary.
- Write a story using a familiar character.
- Make a cake with an adult and write some adjectives to describe it.
- Choose your favourite fairy tale and write an alternative ending.

Reading Activities:

Spelling Activities:
