Writing Activities:

- Practise handwriting using your common exception words for Year 1.
- Spend 5 minutes each day writing a diary.
- Write some sentences about your favourite things using the correct capital letters and full stops.
- Write a short story about a super hero. What powers does he have?
- Make something with an adult and write instructions on how to make it.

Reading Activities:

- Read, read and read!
- Design a new book cover for your favourite story.
- Write a book review.
- Invent a new character for one of your books. Draw and describe them. What is their name? What part would they play in the story? What do they look like?

Other Activities:

- Make a family collective worship.
- Create a storyboard for your favourite Bible story.
- Have a look at your recycling. Can you sort the materials?
