Dear Parents / Carers,

As you already know school will be fully open again on 8th March to all children. It has been a long seven and a half weeks for everyone and we sincerely thank you all for your support during this period. We are delighted to be welcoming all children back into school and back into the school routines. We will be mindful of the pupils' well-being as they return to school and will offer any necessary support to help them with the transition.

I just want to take this opportunity to remind you of some of the measures we have in place to help protect each other and ask you to abide by please:

- Only one parent to drop off / pick up your child.
- Wear a mask when on school premises. We have many anxious staff and parents, including adults living with people who have to shield, so please wear a face mask.
- Keep to the left when walking on school premises.
- Keep 2m away from other people.
- If your child displays any of the 3 main Coronavirus symptoms (high temperature, loss/change to their sense of taste or smell or a new, continuous cough), please keep them off school and arrange a test.

All the safety measures that we had in place in school in the autumn term will continue when the children fully return. The children will continue to be in class bubbles, sat side by side on forward facing desks and will continue to have staggered start, break, lunch and finish times. They will also be regularly washing / sanitising their hands and will have designated toilets. Children will wear their school uniforms each day unless they have PE. On PE days, the children may come into school in their PE kit. Areas around school will continue to be cleaned throughout the course of the day.

Staff will wear masks when moving around the school and many staff are voluntarily taking lateral flow tests twice a week to confirm that they are not Covid positive. We want St Clare's to be as safe as it can be for all our staff and pupils.

The Year 4 swimming programme will hopefully commence after the Easter holidays. We will be in touch regarding start dates for this once they are finalised.

Breakfast club and TOOSC will operate again from 8th March. Breakfast club will open at 7.45am and you may book your places on the school app from Friday 5th March 2021.
