

### English

Our class book is called 'Lubna and the Pebble'.

We will be looking at story narratives and non-chronological reports.

### Science

Our topic this half term is rocks, soils and fossils. The children will develop their scientific skills by planning some experiments, learning new scientific language and observing different rock formations.

### Design Technology

This half term, we will put our building skills to the test when we create our own 3D models of a volcano. We will need to think about structure, building materials and design.

### Maths

This half term, we will be exploring place value. The children will be learning to count objects up to 1000 and to represent 3 digit numbers.

We will move onto addition and subtraction towards the end of the term.

### Religion

This half term, we will start by looking at families and what makes a house a home. We will move on to spend a week looking at Judaism before we begin to think about the sacrament of Reconciliation.

### Geography

Our topic this half term is volcanoes and earthquakes. Children will study how volcanoes are formed and which parts of our earth are susceptible to this natural disasters. We will think about why some areas are affected more than others. We will study some famous volcanoes like Mount St. Helens.

### Music

The children will develop their rhythm. They will learn to think about tempo and beat
