# Year 1 Home Learning Activities



## **Topic/ Science Activities**

- Practice writing your name in bubble writing. Can you design a superhero badge using your initials?
- Interview your grown up. What was life like when they were little? What was their school like? What did they like to play with?
- Design a creature that has the body of a mammal, the head of an amphibian, the tail of reptile and the legs of a bird.
- Place a carrot top or tops in a bowl, cut side down. Fill
  the bowl with about an inch of water so the top is halfway
  covered. Place the dish in a sunny windowsill and change
  the water every day.

## **Religion Activities**

- Lent is a time to change our behaviour to be more like Jesus. Have a look at the picture cards below and act them out with your grown up/sibling. How could you change the bad behaviour to make everyone happier? Act it out.
- Read the story of how Jesus healed the Blind Man (Matthew 9.27-31)

### **Maths Activities**

- Help your adult with the washing. How many socks can you count? Pair them up. How many pairs have you got?
- Write a mix of numbers from 1-20 on the floor outside (use chalk or a stone!) Throw a ball. Add the two numbers that you hit together.
- Write numbers on the floor. Kick a ball. Subtract the number you hit from 20.
- Count the number of tins in your cupboards. Sort them into groups by what's inside them. How many groups have you got? What is the most popular food in a tin in your house?
- Share fruit into portions into 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Find the heaviest object in the kitchen. Find the lightest.
- Count the letters in your first name and your surname. Add them together.
- Count the words on the page in your book. Subtract them from 20.
- Practise telling the time to o'clock and half past.
